Practical Information

In this leaflet we give you some practical information concerning your stay here in Leuven and for WEWoRC. If you have specific questions to specific topics which are not covered here, please contact the person mentioned. If you cannot find her/him, contact any member of the local organising team.

Registration (*questions: Péla Noë, Elke De Mulder*)

You should register directly upon arrival, collect your badge, give us your choice of dinner (see below), and maybe book events for the social programme.

Presentations (*questions: Joe Lano, Dries Schellekens*)

Please contact your session chair before your individual session and either test that your own laptop works well with the beamer or that your presentation can be displayed well on one of the COSIC laptops. In addition to a beamer, you can also use the black board. If you need any special equipment, please contact us.

Venues

We have three different venues for presentations: the Auditorium A (00.57) on the ground floor, and the lecture rooms 01.57 and 01.60 on the first floor. In addition there is a social room with Internet connection in 00.57. All rooms are marked on the map of the ESAT building provided to you. On the map you got, ESAT is building 211 (H4).

Lunch (*questions: An Braeken*)

Lunches take place between noon and 2pm in the student restaurant Alma 3 (see map, G4, building with number 2). We have special places there reserved for WEWoRC. People who paid the full fee, *i.e.*, did not choose the budget option, obtain three tickets (one for each day), to get a full meal in Alma. A full meal consists of a soup, a main dish, a salad, a desert, and some soft drink. People who paid budget may join, but have to pay cash at the till.

Coffee Breaks (*questions: An Braeken and Elke De Mulder*)

Coffee, tea, fruit juice, and some biscuits are provided during coffee breaks. They take place in front of Auditorium A (Room 00.54).

Internet (*questions: Dries Schellekens*)

In Room 00.57, there are some Linux machines for public Internet access. Login is “later” with password “later”. In addition, you can use the WLAN of the K.U.Leuven with the following credentials:

In case you have your own laptop but no WLAN does not work, there are a free spare ports, so you can connect using an UTP cable.

Dinner (*questions: An Braeken*)

The dinner takes place on Wednesday, July 6 from 19:30 onwards in the restaurant Troubadour (Tel.: 016 / 22.50.65). The menu consists of tomato soup, a main dish, and dame blanche. For the main course, you have the choice between a fish dish, Vol-au-vent, and a vegetarian salad. Default dish is fish. If you prefer another choice, please notify us until Tuesday noon on the registration desk, otherwise, we assume that you take the fish. The restaurant is located in Tiensestraat 32 / Muntstraat 27 (E6/7 on the map you got during registration). Dinner is included in the normal registration fee, but **not** in the budget registration. People with budget registration or accompanying people may sign up for the dinner until Tuesday noon at the registration desk (additional 25 euro per person).

Social Programme
